**Subject:** Discussion of Fire Hydrant Painting RFQ Submittal

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**Background:** The City has been installing fire hydrants in the City's distribution system since 1882; the total number of fire hydrants in our distribution is approximately 1,200. The typical coating that was applied to the hydrants, when they were shipped from the foundry and that City crews have subsequently applied additional coatings, were with lead-based paint. In 1978, new rules banning the use of lead-based paint from the Consumer Products Safety Commission came into effect, and enforcement was delegated to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Fire hydrants manufactured since 1978 have a different formulation of paint to provide a protective coating that is not lead-based.

**Discussion:** A Request for Qualification was written, advertised, and one submittal was reviewed, since only one submittal was received. Cryder Enterprises, from Minooka, IL submitted a cost to paint a pre-1978 fire hydrant at \$200/hydrant and to paint a post-1978 fire hydrant at \$100/hydrant, with the City to take possession of the media and paint chips for disposal.

**Funding:** There is sufficient funding in the Water & Sewer budget for this task to be completed, with the start date to perform this task is April 2019; this start date is at my request, to ask for additional funds to continue this project in FY2020, so I can leverage/reduce the disposal fees to the Water & Sewer Department's budget benefit.

**Request:** Staff requests the approval from the City Council, to enter into a contract with Cryder Enterprise, out of Minooka, IL to perform the task of painting the fire hydrants in the City's distribution system.

## Description of Services Rendered

RE: Fire Hydrants-W&S -FHP18

The city has hydrants that need painting. There are currently hydrants that were painted prior to and after 1979. The hydrants painted prior to 1979, proper containment has to be executed. The City will have to properly dispose of contaminated debris. The cost to complete this job will be higher due to the hydrants having a possible lead content. This job would require two professional employees at prevailing wage on the job. Due to the timing of this bid, the job may be completed near the end of the <sup>fiscal</sup> city year, spring 2019. The debris will be contained the best it can and vacuumed at the site of the hydrant. The debris will be properly disposed of at the direction of the Utility Operation Director.

Those painted prior to 1979, the cost would be \$200.00 per hydrant. Each hydrant would be sandblasted, debris contained, vacuumed and disposed of by city. Then, the hydrant would be painted yellow.

Those painted after 1979, the cost would be \$100.00 per hydrant. Each hydrant would be sandblasted and painted yellow.

Cryder Enterprises will provide all labor, materials and other necessary items to complete the project. Work will be done five days a week under good weather conditions. If awarded this project, work will begin in September and will be completed in a timely manner.
