On September 1, 2017, 11:00 a.m., sealed bids for three black 2017 police pursuit sedans or SUVs were opened at City Hall. Present for the opening were City Manager Lowell Crow, Police Fleet Officer Lt Aaron Dykema and Chief Todd Barkalow.

There were 3 sealed bids received for a police pursuit vehicle, two bids from Napleton Fleet of Oak Brook Terrace IL and one bid from Sawicki Motors Freeport, IL. After reviewing the bids, it was determined that one of the bids from Napleton Fleet did not meet the minimum specifications for All-Wheel or Front Wheel drive.

All accepted bids were compared against the State bid of a 2017 Ford Interceptor sedan and SUV from Morrow Brothers located in Greenfield, IL.

The acceptable bid from Napleton Fleet was a 2018 V-8 All-Wheel drive Dodge Charger.

- The bid was \$28,069 per squad
- 3 squads for \$84,207
- Less the trade-in value of \$7000 bringing the total per squad \$25,735 per squad
- **Delivery 10 weeks**

Sawicki Motors submitted a bid for 2018 V-8 All-Wheel drive Dodge Charger.

- \$29,202 per squad
- 3 Squads for \$87,606
- Less a trade-in value of \$15,100 bringing the total per squad \$24,168 per squad
- **Delivery 8 weeks**

Morrow Brothers Ford (State Bid) was for a 2017 Police Interceptor sedan or SUV Utility

- \$25,260 for the All-Wheel drive Interceptor Sedan w/remote keyless entry
- \$28,260 for the All-Wheel Ford Interceptor SUV w/remote keyless entry
- Less a trade-in value of \$4,800 bringing the total per sedan \$23,660
- **Immediate delivery**

Vehicles used for the trade-In

- 2011 Travel Squad (unmarked)
- 2011 Detective Squad (unmarked)
- 2014 current F3 (unmarked)

I would recommend acceptance of the low bid from Morrow Brothers Ford (State Bid) for the 2017 Police Interceptor Ford sedans for \$23,660 per squad.

- \$23,660 X 3 \$70,980
 - Wrapping 3 squads (In God We Trust) added \$4,800
 - 3 Prisoner backseat insert \$2,000
 - 3 Squad change over w/new brackets (Mobile Electronics) \$4,200
- \$81,980

That would leave \$28,020 out of the \$110,000 budgeted in Capital Equipment Fund 31.

My recommendation would be to use this \$28,020 plus additional funds from the special K9 account fund to purchase a state bid SUV K9 squad for \$28,260.
