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Electrical Power to the Accessory Side Locked in "Park" with Keys Removed. To Be Located on Dash or Other Freeport Police Department Approved Location. Air Conditioner, Heater, & Trunk Release Shall Remain Operable When the Switch is engaged.

- Radio Suppression – All Electrical Equipment Shall be Shielded or Have Filtering Installed to Eliminate Radio Interference in the 39 MHZ to 47 MHZ, 150 MHX to 160 MHX & 821 MHZ to 869 MHZ Ranges.
- Wig-wag head lights
- Pull-Out Tray for Radio Installation
- 100-Watt Siren/Speaker Mounted Behind Grill. May be Dealer Installed
- Taillights to Include Factory Installed Flashing LED.
- Headlights to Include Factory Installed Flashing LED.
- Daytime Running Lights with on/off switch
- All Electrical Connections To Be Soldered & Protected by Heat Shrink Material Except When Connecting to A Device That May Require Component Replacement. All Wiring Must Be Protected by Grommets Through Drilled Holes in Vehicle. All Circuits Are to Be Protected By Fuses or Circuit Breakers at Point of Original Power
