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RESOURCES**

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WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Freeport, Illinois (“City”) in November 2016, approved a referendum adopting the City Manager form of government for the City of Freeport; and

WHEREAS, following the passage of the referendum, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/5-3-7, the City amended the City of Freeport Code of Ordinances to create the position of City Manager and to proscribe the duties and responsibilities assigned to the position; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to create the position of Deputy City Manager of Finance, Community Development and Human Resources as set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to amend Title Six Administration to create a new Section regarding the Deputy City Manager of Finance, Community Development and Human Resources and to provide for the qualifications, powers and duties of such position as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREEPORT, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1. The above-recitals are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

Section 2. Title Six, Administration, is hereby amended to add Section 224.07 Deputy City Manager as follows:

- 224.07 Deputy City Manager of Finance, Community Development and Human Resources, Position Created, Appointment.
- 224.08 Term and Compensation.
- 224.09 Powers and Duties.

224.07 DEPUTY CITY MANAGER OF FINANCE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND HUMAN RESOURCES, POSITION CREATED, APPOINTMENT.

There is hereby created the position of Deputy City Manager of Finance, Community Development and Human Resources, an administrative office of the City of Freeport, Illinois. The Deputy City Manager may also serve as the Finance Director without any additional

compensation. The position shall be filled by appointment of the City Manager. The Deputy City Manager shall be subject to the provisions of Sections 288.04 et. seq. which provide for the appointment, term of office, removal from office and vacancy in office.

Any person newly appointed to serve as the Deputy City Manager of Finance, Community Development and Human Resources shall reside within the corporate limits of the City within six months of the date of his/her appointment.

224.08 TERM AND COMPENSATION.

The Deputy City Manager shall be appointed, and may be removed from office, with or without cause, by the City Manager. The Deputy City Manager shall receive such compensation as is set forth in the Salary Schedule provided in Chapter 290, and the Deputy City Manager shall be subject to all rules and regulations set forth in Chapter 290.

224.09 POWERS AND DUTIES.

The Deputy City Manager of Finance, Community Development and Human Resources shall provide oversight over the Department of Finance and Budget, the Department of Community and Economic Development, and the Department of Human Resources. In the absence of the City Manager, the Deputy City Manager shall assume the powers and duties of the City Manager. The Deputy City Manager shall also perform such other duties as may be prescribed or may be required of him by ordinance or resolution of the City Council.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage by the City Council, its approval by the Mayor, and its publication as provided by law.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed insofar as they conflict.

Section 5. If any section, clause or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid, and this City Council hereby expressly declares that it would have enacted this Ordinance even with the invalid portion deleted.
