

GREASE TRAP EXEMPTION REQUEST FORM

Installation of a grease trap is required per City of Freeport Ordinance 1046.12 for Food Service Establishments (FSE). A grease trap may not be required for establishments that only sell/serve/provide clear drinks and/or prepackaged foods. The Director of Public Works or his/her agent may approve an exemption from the installation of a grease trap if specific requirements are met. Grease trap exemption requests are evaluated on an individual basis and may be rescinded or modified if the menu, kitchen equipment, seating capacity or other factors are changed in a way resulting in the discharge of fats, oils and/or grease to the sanitary sewer system.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The FSE will warm prepackaged foods in their original packages, utilizing a microwave oven.

The FSE will only sell/serve/ provide ready-to-eat foods, with no preparation other than warming. The FSE will sell/serve/provide only clear drinks. Clear drinks are those which do not include ingredients that coagulate and/or precipitate from solution (i.e. milk products, fruit ,vegetable, or protein/energy powders)

LEVEL 2

The FSE will sell/serve/provide cold sandwiches only

The FSE will sell/serve/provide scooponly ice cream The FSE will sell/serve/provide popcorn

The food service facility will have a hot dog roller

The FSE will prepare uncooked or unbaked food or meals that will be taken from the facility to be cooked and/or baked elsewhere.

LEVEL 3

The FSE will utilize the following kitchen equipment:

3-Compartment Sink Oven
Dishwasher Griddle
Wok Stove Deep Fryer

Mixers/Blenders

Flat top grill

Garbage Disposal

Application must be completed in its entirety to be considered for exception. Please e-mail the completed application to the, Environmental & Regulatory Compliance Officer compliance@cityoffreeport.org. For questions please call 815-396-3548. During review of the request for exemption, the Environmental & Regulatory Compliance Officer may elect to inspect the FSE and it's sewer lateral during normal business hours. The final decision on granting an exemption will be provided in writing within twenty-one (21) business days after the completed application is received. No exemption is granted except by the Director of Public Works or by his/her agent.
